

Teak wood degreyer

Water-based cleaner · de-greys & brightens greyed hardwood · removes green growth & deposits · for teak, bangkirai, oak, larch and more

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Wood dry and clean before treatment; after de-greying, protect with a care oil.

CAIRCON Teak wood degreyer is a water-based cleaner for the deep cleaning and brightening of untreated teak, hardwood, oak, bangkirai, Siberian larch and other wooden furniture. It refreshes wood surfaces, removes green growth, deposits and impurities and restores the original wood colour to weathered, greyed surfaces. Use on furniture, pergolas, gazebos, ship planks, garden furniture, wooden decks and planters.

IMPORTANT – WEAR PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: When working, wear protective gloves, protective clothing and eye/face protection (P280). Keep out of reach of children and store locked up.

1 · PREPARE THE SUBSTRATE

1	Clean First clean the substrate — we recommend the Teak & hardwood cleaner (undiluted; scrub/brush the wood during the contact time). Alternatively, remove dust and dirt by hand; the surface must be dry and clean.
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2 · APPLY

2	Moisten & apply Moisten the surfaces to be treated with water, then spray the degreyer on generously and brush it in along the grain with a hard root brush; let it act for approx. 10–15 minutes.
3	Rinse off Remove the loosened greying with the hard brush and plenty of water.
4	Protect For protection, coat the de-greied surface with the Teak & Bangkirai oil — this protects against renewed greying, weathering, drying out and green growth.

MAKE A TEST AREA: Check the application beforehand in an inconspicuous spot — wood species react differently.

10–15 min

LET ACT

After letting it act, rinse off with plenty of water.

For protection, oil the de-greied surface afterwards.
