

Spatula/Squeegee Set 6-pcs – Flat Scraper, Smoothing Trowel, Sponge Board & Accessories – Tool Set for Plaster, Wall Spatula & Drywall

Product Description

The 6-piece spatula and plaster tool set was specially developed for precise filling, smoothing and plastering work in interior design and drywall construction.

It enables even application, clean smoothing and fine refinishing of plaster, filler and plasterboard surfaces.

Included tools:

Squeegee scraper 50 cm, smoothing trowel 28 × 13 cm, sponge board 28 × 14 cm, mixing rod, masking tape and work gloves.

1. Preparation of the substrate

- The substrate must be clean, dry and stable.
- Completely remove dust, loose parts, old paint residues or wallpaper.
- Pretreat highly absorbent substrates with a suitable primer if necessary.
- Mask edges, transitions and adjacent surfaces cleanly **with the masking** tape (30 mm).

2. Mixing filler or plaster

- Prepare filler, plaster or gypsum according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Insert **the mixing rod (Ø 8 cm, length 40 cm)** into a commercially available drill.
- Mix material evenly and lump-free.
- Stir again after a short resting period.

3. Applying the material

- Apply filler or plaster to the **wall or ceiling with the** smoothing trowel (28 × 13 cm) or directly with the squeegee scraper.
- Distribute material evenly and pull forward roughly.
- Remove excess compound

4. Smoothing the surface

- Smooth 50 cm large areas in long, even strokes with the squeegee scraper.
- Apply even pressure to achieve a level surface.
- Clean the tool regularly to obtain clean results.

5. Finishing with the sponge board

- As soon as the filler has slightly set but is still wet, finish the surface with the sponge board (28 × 14 cm).
- Lightly moisten the sponge board and guide it over the surface in circular movements.
- This evens out small irregularities and refines the surface.

6. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Clean tools with water immediately after use.
- Dry stainless steel tools thoroughly to increase their lifespan.
- Rinse the sponge board and let it air dry.

Safety Instructions

- Always wear work **gloves (size L) when** working.
- Avoid eye contact with filler or plaster material.
- Only work in well-ventilated rooms.
- Store tools out of reach of children.
