

Application Instructions

Teak Wood Restorer

The restorer can be used to remove the patina from greyed wood

TYPE: CAIRCON

This water-based cleaner is ideal for basic cleaning and brightening untreated teak, hardwood, oak, bangkirai, Siberian larch and other wooden furniture. It refreshes wood surfaces and removes green deposits, residues and other contamination. The Teak Wood Restorer returns weathered and greyed wood surfaces to their former wood colour.

Areas of use:

Furniture, pergolas, gazebos and ship planks with hardwood surfaces such as teak, robinia, mahogany, beech, oak, Douglas fir and bangkirai. Old and new garden furniture, tool sheds, timber decking, teak planters, etc.

Recommended additional products:

Teak and Hardwood Cleaner (substrate preparation)
Teak and Bangkirai Care Oil (protection and care)

Application:

The substrate should be cleaned first. We recommend our Teak and Hardwood Cleaner for this purpose; apply it undiluted and scrub or brush the wood while the teak cleaner is working. Alternatively, dust and dirt can be removed from the surface by hand; for treatment, the surface must then be dry and clean.

Moisten the surfaces to be treated with water. Then spray on a generous amount of Teak Wood Restorer, brush it into the wood along the grain using a stiff scrubbing brush and leave it to work for approx. 10-15 minutes. Afterwards, remove the loosened grey discolouration with the stiff brush and plenty of water.

To protect restored wood surfaces, we recommend coating the surface with our Teak and Bangkirai Care Oil. This protects your wood from renewed greying, weathering, drying out, exposure to the weather and the formation of green deposits.

Ingredients: aqueous solution of special surface-active substances formulated for the natural material wood.

AQUA, PEG-8, ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, TRIDECETH-9, BENZALKONIUM CHLORIDE, SODIUM BICARBONATE, SODIUM POLYASPARTAT

PARFUM, SODIUM DIETHYLENETRIAMINE PENTAMETHYLENE PHOSPHONATE, SODIUM CHLORIDE.
